ure of Survey FIRST ENTRY.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the London Surveyors should be informed that this vessel has been towed to Yarmouth, at which port it is reported she will be fitted with her machinery, and to complete the survey on the hull, the E. & B. casing tops require to be riveted and the casing stiffeners to be completed, and the strong beams and pillars between E. & B. space to be riveted. They should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the survey to forward a report on Form 8 in the usual manner, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
