M With reference to your letter of the 18th instant forwarding one from Mr. Nash respecting the equipment proposed to be supplied to the vessel No. 235 now being built by Messrs. W. J. Yarwood & Sons, I am directed to inform you that provided the weight of the anchor be not less than $1\frac{1}{2}$ cwts. the equipment proposed will be approved for the figure 1.

The equipment of the vessel will then be as follows, viz:-


- 1 Anchor 1 cwt. 1 qr. 0 lb.
- 45 fathoms $\frac{1}{2}$ " link chain cable
- 45 fathoms $3\frac{3}{4}$ " hawser
- 45 fathoms 3" hawser.
