Dear Sirs,

I beg to refer to the correspondence which took place in August 1911 between us respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steam trawlers "DELTA A and "DELTA B". In your letter of the 17th August 1911 you indicated that in 1912 the two steamers were likely to become your entire property, when it was understood you would be prepared to submit them for the surveys prescribed by the Society's Rules.

Since that time the trawlers have become due for Special Survey No.1 under the Rules and the screw shafts are overdue for examination, and in the circumstances I have to say that the Committee will be glad to learn what steps you intend taking to have the surveys held so as to entitle the vessels to retain their classification.

Awaiting the favour of an early reply.


