The Special Survey No.1 of these Belgian steam trawlers became due in September, 1912, and the year of grace expired at the end of last month.

In August, 1911, the Owners stated they wished to withdraw the classes, but they expected this would only be for one or two years, at the end of which time the vessels would become their own property, and the Amsterdam Surveyor explained that the Owners were obliged to take this step by the Mortgagees.

In the circumstances no action was taken in the matter by the Committee as no survey was actually due, but on the vessels becoming due for the Special Survey No.1 letters were addressed to the Owners on several occasions without however obtaining a reply.

The Classing Committee had the matter again before them on the 3rd instant, when it was decided to give effect to the Owners original request and to withdraw the classes, and insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof.
