Nature of Survey DAMAGE.

This vessel is reported by the Colombo Surveyor  
to have sustained damage to her shell plating through collision whilst  
at her moorings Temporary repairs have been effected to his satis-  
faction to enable her to proceed on her voyage to Bombay.

The Surveyor recommends that the vessel be placed in dry  
dock for further examination on her arrival at Bombay.

It is submitted action be deferred pending the receipt  
of a report from the Bombay Surveyor, S - Belfast.
