The HULL Surveyors report the vessel examined afloat after grounding (apparently soon after the recent Survey, at Hull in dry dock) soundings taken and no signs of leakage or damage found.

The Surveyors, however, recommend further examination in dry dock at the first opportunity.

It is submitted action be deferred for dry docking.
