Remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The class is subject to shell plates D1. (p & s.a) E.W. 6.39 C3 (p & s) and B2 (s.s) E.W. 12.39 being specially examined at the next dry docking.

The MILFORD HAVEN Surveyor reports 6.41.vessel afloat and ~~the vessel~~ extensively damaged after Enemy Action and recommends the vessel proceed to Npt after dry docking and permanent repairs.

The NEWPORT MON. Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock and bottom coated and extensive renewals or repairs effected to shell and deck plating, frames, floors, beams and bulkheads. (See Summary)


A bower anchor and 45 fathoms of chain cable are missing.

The Surveyors recommend the deficiency in equipment be made good at the end of the present emergency. *status not*

Shell plates C3 (p & s) have now been permanently repaired, and the remainder continue efficient.
The 1st S.S. No.3 due 12.42 has been held and minor repairs effected.

A Marconi Echo Sounding device has been fitted.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed and to have record of survey 2.42. and notation of S.S. No.3. 2.42. subject (as recommended) and as above except as regards shell plates C3 (p & s).
