I return herewith one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 27th ultimo of midship section and profile and decks for a single screw steamer No. 279 proposed to be built by Messrs. Bartram & Sons, Ltd., and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1 with a freeboard corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by the Rules for a complete superstructure vessel having a tonnage opening.

It is observed from the records in this Office that this vessel is of similar dimensions and type to the same Builders' No. 278, and I have to point out that the work here would be facilitated if, in submitting plans of new vessels, you would draw attention to any previous similar cases.

The duplicate copies of the plans are being retained for reference.
