I duly received your letter of the 1st instant, forwarding plans, in duplicate, of Combustion Chamber Superheaters to be supplied for the above contracts, and in reply have to inform you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 240 lb. per sq. inch, provided a safety valve be fitted to each part of the superheaters which can be isolated from the boilers, the superheaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the whole be tested to three times the working pressure.

One set of the plans is returned herewith, the remaining copies having been forwarded to the Society's Surveyors concerned for their guidance. I shall be obliged if you will kindly furnish me with an additional set for record purposes in this Office.

I also take the opportunity to enclose the usual Survey Request form for completion.
