I duly received your letter of the 29th ultimo, with enclosures, respecting the Boilers No.37/11 and Aux.37/11 proposed by Messrs. Barclay Curle & Co., Ltd., for Messrs. Bartram & Sons' Yard No.279, and have to acquaint you that the plan of main boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 240 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

Further, the plan of auxiliary boiler will be approved for a working pressure of 240 lb. per sq. inch, provided a riveted washer be fitted to the through stay above the manhole at the lower back end plate as shown on the plan and the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps of both main and auxiliary boilers, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.
