The First Special Survey No.3 became due on this steamer in December, 1915, and action has been deferred by the Committee from time to time in view of the vessel having been at Sulina.

As the vessel was stated to be under the direct orders of the Ministry of Marine of the Volunteer Army of General Denikine at Taganrog, the Constantinople Surveyor was requested on the 5th December last to place himself in communication with this Department with a view to the Special Survey being held forthwith or the vessel would lose her class.

As no reply to the Surveyor's enquiries has been received by him, the Classing Committee on Tuesday the 30th ultimo decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line^(3.20), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

A cablegram has since been received from the Constantinople Surveyors stating that they cannot obtain any information from the local Office.
