Clearkos Ksegakis of Braila, latter was addressed to that Firm on the 11th October 1916, inquiring what definite arrangements they proposed making to the outstanding surveys held, but no reply was received in this communication.

The vessel arrived recently at Barcelona from Egypt, the Surveyor at that port was asked to state whether the outstanding surveys were being held. In reply he cables that arrangements have been made to have the requisite inspections carried out, but that the vessel was drydocked and her screw drawn at Alexandria. On the 21st ultimo the Surveyors that the Owners are - The Russian Government, Russian Base, Constantinople.
