On the 7th of March 1917 and subsequent dates for the purpose of inspecting, during construction, portions of the machinery intended to be fitted to board the "Vernoy" class Admiralty Trawler being built by Messrs. Cochrane & Co. of Selby, their Ship No. being 813 and Eng. No. C 15.

The Main Engines & pumps driven by them together with the Screw & intermediate shafts, Thrust block & stern tube have been well constructed in accordance with the plans & specification, the material used having been satisfactorily tested to the rule requirements of Lloyd's Register of Shipping.
