With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "DOLORES", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case under consideration, and that in view of the fact that the Special Survey No.3, which became due so long ago as June 1914, still remains incomplete, and that no definite arrangements have yet been made for the remaining requirements of the inspection to be attended to, they regret that they are unable to allow the vessel to retain her class in the Register Book any longer, and have accordingly given instructions for the character to be expunged with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

I have at the same time to add that the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character in the Society's Register Book upon receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that all requisite surveys and repairs have been carried out.
