S. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had under further consideration to-day the case of your steam trawler "EMMANUEL" - referred to in my letter of the 30th May last, to which I have not had the pleasure of receiving a reply.

The Society's Surveyor at Milford Haven states that no steps have yet been taken to have the screw shaft of this vessel drawn in for examination, as required, and the vessel submitted for general examination.

In the circumstances the Committee desire me to say that unless arrangements are at once made for the above requirements to be complied with, they regret that the steamer must lose her class, and I have accordingly to request you will kindly state what steps you will take in the matter.
