Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letter of the 23rd April last, relative to the Special Survey No. 1 and the Survey of the Screw Shaft of the Steam Trawler "EMMANUEL", I have to acquaint you that I am informed by the Owner that arrangements have been made for the necessary work to be done before the next Winter Season. In reply, the Owner has been informed that in view of the length of time for which the examination of the Shaft has now been outstanding, the Committee cannot agree to this being deferred for the period suggested, and arrangements must be made for the Shaft to be drawn in for examination and the Vessel submitted for inspection not later than the end of this month, if the Trawler is to retain her class.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case attention, and advise me promptly should the Vessel not be submitted to inspection, in accordance with the Committee's decision.
