Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant, with reference to the examination required of the tail shaft of your steamer "EMMANUEL", and the Special Survey No.1 which is due on the vessel, and note your remarks on the subject.

Having submitted the case again to the Committee to-day, I have to say that in view of the length of time for which the examination of the shaft has now been outstanding, the Committee cannot agree to its being deferred for the period suggested in your letter, and arrangements must be made for the shaft to be drawn in for examination, and the vessel submitted for inspection not later than the end of next month, if the steamer is to retain her class.
