Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had under consideration the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Steamer "FACI", which it is understood became your property in the early part of last year.

This vessel is due for the Special Survey No.2 prescribed by the Rules, and the boiler has not been seen by the Society's Surveyors since February, 1918, although required to be surveyed annually in order to the retention of the vessel's class.

The Society's Surveyors at Gibraltar intimates that he addressed a letter to you on the subject on the 27th ultimo, but up to the 10th instant had not been favoured with a reply, and the matter has now been standing over so very long that the Committee regret there is no alternative but for the steamers class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.
