

TRANSLATION.

La Dette Marocaine have sent me a copy of your letter of the 31st January last respecting the Boiler Survey of the Coast Guard Boat "MARAKCHI".

I have the honour to acquaint you that this boat, as well as the other two of the same type - "FACI" and "MEKNASSI" have been handed over, on the 1st January 1919, by the Dette Marocaine to the Protectorat Francais (Customs Service) who have dismantled them to put them up for sale.

It is then absolutely impossible for me, at this time, to have the Coast Guard Boat "MARAKCHI" pass her Boiler Survey, either at Gibraltar or at any other port . However, I have not failed to mention, in the articles drawn up with a view to sale that the "MARAKCHI" is classed in Lloyd's Register.

It will therefore be the duty of the buyer to put himself in order with the requirements of the Rules of your Society.
