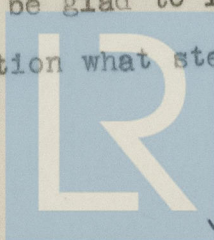

Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "ETELVINA" I beg to remind you that letters in regard to the Special Survey No.1 and the survey of the screw shaft which became due in the case of this vessel at the end of December and April last were addressed to you from this office on the 16th April and 16th July, but no reply has been received to these communications.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have had the case under their consideration, direct me to point out that the survey of the screw shaft is now long overdue and that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the special survey No.1 will expire at the end of the year and to say that definite arrangements must be made for the requisite inspections to be carried out without delay if the vessel is to retain her class.

I shall therefore be glad to learn by return mail for the Committee's information what steps you propose taking
