I have to inform you that it appears from a report on the steel screw steamer No. 525 built by Messrs. Otto & Zonen, received from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam, that this vessel will be towed to Yarmouth, where she will be fitted with her machinery, and that ~~to~~^{to} complete the survey on the hull the engine and boiler casing tops require to be riveted; the casing stiffeners to be completed, and the strong beams and pillars between the engine and boiler space to be riveted.

I have therefore to request that you will be so good as to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work forward a report on Form No. 8 for the information of the Committee with a view to the classification of the vessel.
