Nature of Survey

This vessel was built in 1914, 4 month, and classed 100 A.1.  
Steam Trawler.

The London Surveyors now report the vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated and the s.s. No. 1, due 4.18, carried out.

The vessel is now being used as a cargo vessel, and some minor alterations have been carried out, but the additional strengthening etc. required for the 100 A.1. class has not been fitted, nor has the equipment been made in accordance with the Rules.

In the circumstances it is submitted the class of the vessel should be expunged with a red line, 5.19.
