The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

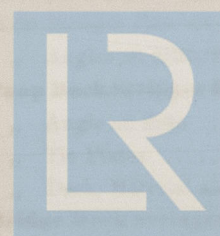

Nature of Survey Leith entry.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee it should be pointed out to the Leith Surveyors that this vessel is described on the first page of their report as a sailing barge and as a vessel to be towed. They should be requested to state whether the vessel has been fitted with masts, rigging and sails for the purpose of sailing out to Buenos Aires only, or whether they are permanent fittings. They should at the same time be requested to furnish the registered dimensions if possible.
