M.V. "Athelchief"

With reference to the Clarkson Boiler fitted to the above vessel, the details of which were approved by your Grimsby office in July 1927, to Drawing No. B.E.1617, (Sheet 1) the owners have decided to have this replaced by a Clarkson Boiler fired by exhaust gas only.

We have therefore prepared Drawing No. 3750.A. and close quadruplicate copies herewith for your guidance.

The working pressure is 100 lbs./sq. inch, and the boiler is of our "GYCENTRIC" design, similar to some you have already approved - that is, the exhaust gas is passed over the tubes which are fitted radiating outwards from the centre shell.

As we have undertaken to manufacture this boiler for delivery in June (to suit the time when the vessel will be in dry dock for repairs) we should esteem it a favour to have your official approval of the scantlings as early as possible, since you are doubtless aware that deliveries of steel plates are at the present time very much delayed, and we wish to get our orders placed immediately.

The boiler will be manufactured for us by Messrs. Abbott & Co., (Newark) Ltd, at their Newark works.

Should any further information be required, please let us know and we will forward it, as the matter is extremely urgent.


