Messrs. John G. Kincaid & Co., Ltd., Engineers, Greenock, surveyed during construction two Steel Air Reservoirs intended for their Engine No. K6, Messrs. The Caledon SB. Co's S. S. No. 295. The material has been tested by the Surveyors to this Society. The Scantlings are in accordance with the Rules for a working pressure of 356 lbs. per square inch. These Reservoirs were tested in the presence of the undersigned to a hydraulic pressure of 556 lbs. per square inch and were found tight at that pressure.

The working pressure should not exceed three hundred and fifty six pounds.


