
Dear Sir;

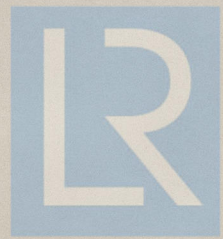
