The class is subject to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied and the remainder of the cable verified with the certificates of test.

The Annual Survey of the oil engines and donkey boiler survey became due 1,22, and a proposal to postpone these surveys for the present was agreed to, subject to the same being carried out before the vessel again proceeded to sea.

The Rio de Janiero Surveyor now states he has been informed by the Owners that they do not wish to continue the classification of the vessel.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
