I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 5th instant respecting the First Entry Report No. 8197 on the Steel Screw Steamer "NEW MEXICO", and with regard thereto I have to state that the arms of the Cast Steel Rudder are fitted *at* and between the rudder pintles on this vessel, the hand pumps as fitted are in efficient working order, and the margin angles on the tank top should be 7.5, as in the sister vessels.

I regret that this item was incorrectly reported.
