Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the percentage of fee chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the S.S. "NEW MEXICO" (your first entry report No. 8197) I have to inform you that in view of the fact that 40% of the work on the Hull and 37.5% of the work on the Machinery was completed as a Standard Vessel, the fees chargeable to the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in this case will be £42 for the survey of the Hull and £56 for the survey of the Machinery, and an account has to-day been rendered accordingly.

You will therefore be good enough to see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Book in the usual way.
