E. I return herewith the plan forwarded with your letter of the 6th instant, of boilers proposed by The Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co.Ld. for their Contract No.357B for the s.s. "LUTETIAN", and have to acquaint you that this plan of boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 180 lb. per sq.inch, provided the position of the through stays at the lower back plate be amended as indicated on the plan and the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing and to your entire satisfaction.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates, butt straps and girders, viz:- 29/33 tons per sq.inch.

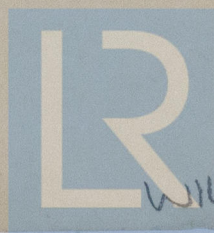
