Mr. Johnson, representing the Wallsend Slipway & Engineering Co., has called at this Office, and handed in two plans, in duplicate, showing the proposed alterations to the structure in connexion with the conversion of the vessel from coal to oil burning.

One of these plans, showing the modifications in way of the boilers, has already been dealt with.

The remaining plan, showing the scantlings proposed for the new oil fuel bunker, have been discussed with Mr. Johnson, and it is submitted that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and amended on the plan and to the Surveyors' satisfaction, the same will merit approval.

Mr. Johnson will call at this Office this morning, and will take away one copy of this plan, and the remaining copy should be forwarded to the Newcastle Surveyors for their information and guidance in the survey of the vessel.
