Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steam Trawler "HONDO", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby state they are informed by your Superintendent that it is not intended to retain this vessel's classification with this Society.

With regard to this case, I would point out that upon the occasion of the vessel being generally examined at Grimsby in January last, it was stated that the overdue surveys would be carried out in June, and in view of the fact that this arrangement has not been adhered to, the Committee who have had the case before them at their Meeting to-day, regret they have now no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that upon the receipt of a satisfactory Report from the Society's Surveyors on the completion of the necessary survey, the case will receive the favourable consideration of the Committee, with a view to the reinstatement of the class.
