Nature of Survey

First entry.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Newcastle Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is to have her machinery fitted on board at Smith Shields, and the following will require to be examined when completed:—

The engine and boiler casing, fastening of engine room skylight, and the riveting and caulking of top of tunnel.

The surveyors should give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to give satisfactory report upon the same for the information of the Committee in form no. 8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
