The Calcutta Surveyor now reports that this vessel has been examined in drydock after grounding as recommended by him in January last and the bottom and rudder which were found to be uninjured have been cleaned and coated.

The vessel has recently been purchased by the British India Steam Navigation Co., and the Surveyor states he is informed by the Owners representative that it is intended to maintain her classification until the next Special Survey becomes due in January 1914.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 2,13 as recommended.
