Gentlemen,

E. With reference to Mr. Field's first entry report No. 50,000 on the machinery of the S.S. "HYMETTUS", I have to call your attention to the fact that as this vessel is fitted with an auxiliary boiler, the heating surface of the same should be taken into account in calculating the nominal horse power. In this case therefore the nominal horse power for record in the Register Book will be 580, not 539 as stated on ~~your~~ report, and the special survey fee will consequently be £49, and an amended account should be rendered to the Builders for this amount.
