Nature of Survey Letters Not When due 2, 13  
Withdrawal of class.

The Liverpool Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners from which it appears that as the vessel is not insured classification is not needed, and the Owners therefore request that the class be withdrawn from the Register Book.

The year of grace expires at the end of February next. It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn

from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
