Précis of particulars of Casualty Beached on the North East Molasses Reef, Florida, after collision with the tanker "Robert C. Tuttle" on the 9th April, 1942.

The bow was crushed back, the vessel was resting on coral in 54 feet of water and was flooded throughout.

No salvage was attempted and in reply to inquiry, it is understood from Lloyd's that this steamer is a total loss.
