Exd. 3,41 (12 mos.). Bower anchor and 30 fms. cable to supply. Indntd. pltg. &c., abreast No. 1 hatch and poop side pltg., &c., to be dealt with as necessary on rtn. U.K.

being fit to carry dry and perishable cargo.
