Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 22nd ultimo, regarding the extension of W.T. bulkheads in the s.s. "BARNWILL", I think it well to inform you that since that date further instructions have been received in regard to the drainage of the 'tween deck spaces formed by the extension of these bulkheads. Section 29, paragraph 2(a) of the Society's Rules requires the fitting of scuppers sufficient in number and size to provide thoroughly effective drainage in all decks. Each of the spaces formed by the extension of the watertight bulkheads in the shelter 'tween decks should therefore be drained to the bilges by a scupper pipe on each side of the ship, placed so far as practicable in the most effective position having regard to the sheer of the deck. The Ministry, however, desire that the work involved should be kept to a minimum.
