LLOYD NACIONAL VESSELS.

We beg to acknowledge receipt of your favour of 26th inst. enclosing the Classification Certificates in duplicate of both Hull and Machinery of the M/V. "ARARAQUARA".

We are somewhat at a loss to understand why the delivery of these certificates should have been delayed pending your obtaining the sanction of the engine-makers. This we could have understood had your fees not been paid.

It was the shipowners who gave instructions that the vessels were to be built to your classification, and we know of no reason why the engine builders should have any say as to whether or not you should deliver the certificates to the shipowners.

The same delay occurred in the case of the certificates for the "ARARANGUA".
