Dear Sirs,

With reference to Mr. Turnbull's letter of the 18th instant respecting the request which has been received from the Builders of the Motorship "ARARAUARA", for the classification certificates to be handed to Messrs. John Campbell & Sons, of Glasgow, I have now to say that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have cabled, stating that the Engine Builders are agreeable to the machinery certificate being handed over as desired, and the classification certificates both for the hull and machinery have accordingly to-day been forwarded to Messrs. John M. Campbell & Sons.

It is understood that Messrs. Campbell & Sons' arrangement with the Builders was that the certificates should be delivered to them in duplicate, and it is therefore concluded that the charge for the duplicate certificates, viz:-£1.6.0, should be debited to the Builders, and I shall be glad if you will arrange to collect this amount from them.
