I beg to forward herewith a report, on Rpt 8 from, upon the damage sustained by the steamer "Japan" as described in the damage report referred to in the classing letter of the 24<sup>th</sup> ult. The structural damage was very slight, I only made one visit & the repairs to the bulwarks & poop scuttle were in hand by the Mitsubishi Bishi Co & a new accommodation ladder being made also a boat to be made later. I regret that at the time of the survey I overlooked the fact that the vessel was classed & so only wrote a damage report. When the vessel next visits the port a further report on the completion of the repairs shall be sent.
