Dear Sir,

I beg to forward here with a report, on Rpt 8 form, upon the damage sustained by the steamer "Japan" as described in the damage report referred to in the classing letter of the 24th ult. The structural damage was very slight; I only made one visit & the repairs to the bulwark & poop scuttle were in hand by the Mitsui Bishi Co & a new accommodation ladder being made also a ~~hat~~ to be made later. I regret that at the time of the survey I overlooked the fact that the vessel was classed & so only wrote a damage report. When the vessel next visits the port a further report on the completion of the repairs shall be sent.
