With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steam Trawler "JARLINN", I beg to remind you that the Special Survey No. 3 of this vessel, prescribed by the Society's Rules, became due at the end of April 1918, and to enable her to retain her class, it will be necessary either for this survey to be held or for the vessel to be submitted to a General Examination by the Society's Surveyors (including the examination of the boilers and screw shaft), in accordance with the terms of the enclosed Circular Letter.
