With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steam trawler "JARLINN", which vessel it is understood has become your property, I beg to acquaint you that the surveys of the screw shaft and boilers prescribed by this Society's rules became due at the end of September 1916 and March 1917 respectively, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know, for the information of the Committee, what definite arrangements you propose making to have these inspections held.
