Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steamer "JARLINN", I beg to remind you that letters in regard to the surveys which became due on the screw shaft and boiler of this vessel at the end of September 1916 and March 1917 respectively were addressed to you from this office on the 13th of December and 26th of March to which no reply has been received.

In the circumstances, the Committee, who have had the case under their consideration, direct me to request that you will state for their information what definite arrangements you propose making to have the requisite survey of the screw shaft held in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class.

I shall, therefore, be glad to learn what steps you propose taking to have the screw shaft surveyed and the Boiler Survey carried out.
