In reply to your letter of yesterday's date re the anchor equipment of S.S. "LADYWOOD", as per my 1st Entry Report No. 23474, I have to state that the vessel's equipment is in accordance with the approved Midship Section and was recommended as eligible for the figure 1 as in the previous similar vessels.

I much regret however having omitted to record the kedge anchor (together with the rule requirements for stream and kedge) in my report, the particulars of the anchor are as follows, viz:-

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the information as is now required and shall have much pleasure in adhering to same in future cases.

I beg to apologise for the trouble caused by the omissions.
