The Owners now state that it has been decided to discontinue the class of this vessel.

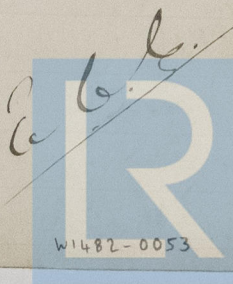
