We hereby engage to pay Special Survey Fees as follows, viz. :—

For boilers up to 200 Nominal Horse Power, one shilling per Horse Power. For boilers over 200 Nominal Horse Power, one shilling per Horse Power for the first 200 Horse Power and fourpence per Horse Power above 200. The Nominal Horse Power to be reckoned at 15 square feet of heating surface. No fee to be less than £2 2s.

MEM.—In exceptional cases an additional charge will be made according to the services performed, and in all cases where travelling expenses are incurred by the Surveyors in connexion with the above services, they are to be defrayed by the parties interested.
