Vessel's Name "KARORI".

This vessel has completed her special survey No.3, and under separate cover I send you Rpt 8 and 9 and Cert.B and B1. I also enclose herewith a copy of a letter I considered it necessary to send to the Owners referring to the condition of some of the main deck plates and an intercostal under the port main boiler, As it was not convenient to effect the repairs at this survey completely, and as it was in my opinion quite safe to let these repairs stand over for 12 months, subject to the Committee approval, I trust you will endorse my action in meeting the exigencies of the Owners business, and also approve of the manner in which I have issued Cert B. I might state that I am sending copies of the letter to the Owners and Cert B to the Society's Surveyors at Sydney and Dunedin, in case the vessel should be under survey at these ports.
